Economic loss **1.8% of GDP**

Tobacco-related illnesses cost Tunisia TND 2 billion every year, which is equivalent to 1.8% of their GDP (2019).

Total of TND 1.9 billion in productivity losses:

- Smoking breaks
- Presenteeism
- Absenteeism
- Premature mortality



The prevalence of tobacco consumption is also particularly high among the male population in Tunisia.


Tobacco-related deaths

Estimated tobacco-attributable deaths per year in Tunisia by disease or condition:






Investing now in seven tobacco control measures will save...

Recommendations

Strengthen multisectoral planning and coordination for tobacco control.

Ensure compliance with the tobacco control regulations.



Strengthen national tobacco control laws.



Raise taxes to at least 75 percent of retail price.



Take action to prevent interference from industry in policymaking and implementation.
